Methodology and Background

Instrument Design and Timeline

The Office of Institutional Research and Assessment administered the University's 2019 Undergraduate Graduating Student Exit Survey from April 23 to May 7, 2019.

The objectives of the survey were to gather information from undergraduate graduating students about their experience during undergraduate studies, the academic environment, extracurricular activities, satisfaction with services provided at the university, and expectations for moving forward, as well as to identify areas of possible improvements.

This report describes the methodology used for the survey and presents the findings in tables.

Sample, Procedures, Response Rate

The survey population included 308 undergraduate graduating students.

An email was sent from the Provost to all freshman students on April 23 highlighting the importance of the survey, requesting participation and providing a direct link to the on-line survey.

In seeking a high response rate, the following course of action was taken:

- Three reminder emails were sent from the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment on April 27, May 2, and May 6.
- Reminder fliers were posted around campus (i.e. academic program offices, cafeteria, student lounge, lobbies).
- Deans, Program Chairs, the Center for Student Success and the Office of the Registrar were asked to promote participation.

A total of 146 (47.40%) out of 308 undergraduate graduating students participated in the survey. The results of 39 partially completed surveys were excluded from the analyses, thus **denoting a response rate of 34.74%.**

To check how well the sample reflected the population with regard to distribution by program and sex, one-sample chi-square test was conducted. According to the test results¹, collected data is representative with the corresponding population by program and sex.

Undergraduate graduating students' by program and by sex distributions in population and in sample are presented in the tables below.

Description

Upon completion of the on-line survey, data was analyzed in SPSS. Descriptive analysis includes frequencies, cross-tabulations by sex and academic program, calculation of mean values for categorical variables with Likert scale type response options, and medians for ordinal categorical variables.

To detect the difference in the mean values of questions and respondents' sex, independent sample t-test was conducted. One-way ANOVA was run to detect the difference in the mean values of questions between academic programs. Two-way ANOVA was run to find interaction between academic program and sex, as well as to explore adjusted results for these factors. ANOVA was run only for the variables for which between-group variances were equal. Post-Hoc tests helped to identify the mean difference between particular academic programs. The significance level used for the statistical tests was 5%. In addition, marginally significant (10%) results were reported for the two-way ANOVA results. The report consists of four main parts: university wide, by program, by sex, and answers to openended questions.

For statements that have a Not Applicable (N/A) response option, the mean value is calculated without including Not Applicable responses. For informational purposes, statements in which Missing Values in the total population and Not Applicable responses combined comprised more than 10% of total responses are marked in white print on black background.

In order to avoid complexity in the tables, response options to the following questions were shortened in all tables:

- Which best describes your potential employer?²
- In what industry is your current/potential employment?

The numbering of the responses in the reports correspond to the numbering in the survey questionnaire (see Appendix 5 for survey questionnaire).
