# 2020 Freshman Student Exit Survey

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## Methodology and Background

## Instrument Design and Timeline

The Office of Institutional Research and Assessment administered the University's 2020 Freshman Student Exit Survey from April 16 to May 1, 2020.

The objectives of the survey were to gather information from freshman students about their first year experience, academic environment, extracurricular activities, satisfaction with services provided at the university, and expectations for upcoming academic year, as well as to identify areas of possible improvements.

This report describes the methodology used for the survey and presents the findings in tables.

## Sample, Procedures, Response Rate

The survey population included 419 freshman students.
An email was sent from the Provost to all freshman students on April 16 highlighting the importance of the survey, requesting participation and providing direct link to on-line survey.

In seeking a high response rate, the following course of action was taken:

- Three reminder emails were sent from the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment (April 19, 23 and 29)
- Deans, Program Chairs, the Center for Student Success and the Office of the Registrar were asked to promote participation.
- Peer mentors encouraged students to complete the survey.

A total of 289 ( $68.9 \%$ ) out of 419 freshman students participated in the survey. The results of 74 partially completed surveys were excluded from the analysis, denoting a response rate of 51.3\%.

Note: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, on March 16, 2020, the AUA transitioned to temporary online teaching and learning, and remained online through the end of the academic year.

## Description

Upon completion of the on-line survey, data was analyzed in SPSS. Descriptive analysis includes frequencies, custom-tables by sex and academic programs, calculation of mean values for categorical variables with Likert scale type response options, calculations of Chi-square for categorical variables with yes/no type response options and medians for ordinal categorical variables.

To check how well the sample reflected the population with regard to distribution by program and by sex chi-square ${ }^{1}$ test was conducted. According to the test results, collected data is representative with the corresponding population program and sex.

To detect the difference in the mean values of questions and respondents' sex, independent sample t -test was conducted. One-way ANOVA was run to detect the difference in the mean values of questions among programs. Two-way ANOVA was run to find interaction between program and sex, as well as to explore adjusted results for these factors. ANOVA was run only for the variables for which between-group variances were equal. Post-Hoc tests helped to identify the mean difference between particular programs. The significance level used for the statistical tests was $5 \%$. In addition, marginally significant ( $10 \%$ ) results were reported for the two-way ANOVA results. The report consists of four main parts: university wide, by college, by sex, and answers to open-ended questions.

The report consists of three main parts: university wide, by program, and answers to openended questions.

For statements that have a Not Applicable (N/A) response option, the mean value is calculated without including Not Applicable responses. For informational purposes, statements in which Missing Values in the total population and Not Applicable responses combined comprised more than $10 \%$ of total responses are marked in white print on black background.

The numbering of the responses in the reports correspond to the numbering in the survey questionnaire (see Appendix for survey questionnaire).
