

2020 Graduate Student Exit Survey

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Methodology and Background

Instrument Design and Timeline

The American University of Armenia (AUA) conducted its 2019-2020 *Graduate Student Exit Survey* from April 16 to April 30, 2020, and from July 20 to August 4, 2020. The University's Office of Institutional Research and Assessment carried out the survey with the support of the provost and the academic programs.

The objectives of the survey were to gather information from graduate students about the level of student satisfaction related to the curriculum, academic environment, extracurricular activities, and services provided at the university, as well as to identify areas of possible improvements.

Demographic data were collected for analysis purposes. Students were informed about the anonymity of their responses in an accompanying cover letter that also provided instructions on how to complete the questionnaire.

This report describes the methodology used for the survey and presents the findings in tables.

Sample, Procedures, Response Rate

The following procedures were followed:

- A letter from the provost was sent to each graduating student with a request to complete the survey. The letter included an explanation of the importance of the survey and the link to the on-line survey.
- Three reminder email messages were sent by the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment.
- Program chairs and administrative assistants were asked to remind students to complete the survey.

¹ For the purposes of this study, a *graduating student* is a student who submitted a Petition to Graduate by the posted deadline. For MSSM students who are scheduled to complete the program in the summer as prescribed by the program but are conferred the following January, a *graduating student* is a student who is enrolled in the final Capstone course.

² Graduate Certificates include Certificate in Translation, Certificate in Teaching English as a Foreign Language, and Certificate in Public Health.

A total of 140 (79.5%) out of 176 graduating students participated in the survey. The results of 30 partially completed surveys were excluded in the analyses, thus **denoting a response rate of 62.5%**.

To check how well the sample reflected the population with regard to distribution by sex and by College/School, one-sample chi-square test was conducted. According to the test results³, collected data is representative with the corresponding population by College/School and sex. As the sample by program is very small the one-sample chi-square test by program was not conducted.

Graduating students' by program, by sex and by College/School distributions in population and in sample are presented in the tables below.

Description

Upon completion of the on-line survey, data was analyzed in SPSS. Descriptive analysis includes frequencies, calculation of mean values for categorical variables with Likert scale type response options.

The report consists of three main parts: university wide report, by College/School report and by program responses to open ended questions. By program, by sex and longitudinal reports are not included in the final report.

For statements that have a Not Applicable (N/A) response option, the mean value is calculated without including Not Applicable responses. For informational purposes, statements in which Missing Values in the total population and Not Applicable responses combined comprised more than 10% of total responses are marked in **white print on black background**.

The numbering of the questions in the report corresponds to the numbering in the survey questionnaire (see Appendix 11 for survey questionnaire).

In order to avoid complexity in the tables, response options to the following questions were shortened in all tables

- Which best describes your potential employer?⁴
- In what industry is your current/potential employment?
