The Faculty Senate is an elected, deliberative body whose primary purpose is to represent the AUA faculty to the administration, Board of Trustees, and other parties. As part of a wider system of shared governance, the Senate is the faculty's voice in the life of the AUA. It represents all faculty, including adjunct faculty and visiting faculty, in matters related to faculty welfare, teaching and learning, research and service, student conduct, admissions, faculty advancement and development, faculty conduct, and more.
