What do we know about freshman students?

The average year of birth of freshman students is around **2003**

Now referred to as Generation Z (Gen Z)

- Also known as Generation Y, Digital Natives, Generation Me, Generation Rent and Echo Boomers: born between 1997-2012
- The first generation to grow up totally immersed digital technology
- This generation can access content anywhere, anytime and on any device
- This generation is skeptical, about everything = Active Learners






Graduation Rate : Undergraduate


Graduation Rate: Graduate

Level of experiencing the stress regarding studies:



Freshman Student Survey Results

First-Year Expectations

- 60% expects to work
- **42%** expects to experience the **stress** regarding studies
- **18%** expects to experience difficulties when learning **new material**
- **33%** expects to experience difficulties when **managing their time**

First-Year Experience

- 37% worked
- 80% experienced the stress regarding studies
- **39%** experienced difficulties when learning **new material**
- 63% experienced difficulties when managing their time


2022-2023 Undergraduate Graduating Students Exit Survey

- 86% are net promoters of AUA
- **78%** agreed that the **interactions** between students & faculty are characterized by **mutual respect**
- 62% reported difficulties with balancing studies, work & home/family life
- 76% agreed that the courses taken were were well taught

2022-2023 AY response rates are low and data may not be fully representative of the entire student population.




Graduating Students Exit Survey Results
